

Professor Hailong Wang, Foshan University, China.

Hailong Wang is a professor in environmental soil science at School of Environment and Chemical Engineering, Foshan University, China. He is also an adjunct professor at Zhejiang University and Zhejiang A&F University. His research program focuses mainly on environmental functions of biochar and environmental remediation. He has published >120 papers in peer-reviewed international scientific journals, with citations >2000 times.

Prof. Wang is the founding Director of the Key Laboratory of Soil Contamination Bioremediation of Zhejiang Province, China, a member of the International Biochar Initiative (IBI) Advisory Committee, an expert of international standing and an assessor for the Australian Research Council, and an editor of "Environmental Science and Pollution Research" and "Journal of Soils and Sediments".
