He earned Ph.D. degree from Hanyang University (1994) in Reproductive Biology with the topic of "Regulation of Acrosome Reaction in Mouse Spermatozoa." His wide knowledge in basic reproductive biology and reproductive endocrinology enables him to successfully carry out endocrine disruption researches using vertebrate models including amphibians as well as mammals at molecular and cellular levels.

Funded by the Korean Ministry of Science and ICT (MIST), Dr. Gye has been the director of the research center for endocrine disruptors since 2015, leading the development of alternatives for major endocrine disrupting chemicals. He is now the president of the Korean Society of Environmental Biology (2018-2019) and the Korean Society for Reproductive Immunology (2017-2018).
